NOTICE OF REDUCTION IN FOUNTAINTOWN GAS RATES TO PHASE-OUT ENERGY EFFICIENCY RIDER.

Fountaintown Gas Company was authorized by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) in Cause Nos. 43995 and 43995 S-1 to recover from its residential customers a total of \$73,414.00 over a period of years in the form of a monthly energy efficiency charge or “rider” of \$0.83. As Fountaintown approaches the point where it has fully collected the authorized amount, and in order to avoid over collecting from customers, Fountaintown has filed a request for the IURC to allow it to reduce the energy efficiency rider specified on its rate tariff to \$0.27 for one month before further reducing that charge to \$0.00 for the next month and thereafter.

Once the charge is eliminated, Fountaintown estimates that its customers will save \$9.96 on an annual basis compared to when the full charge was in effect. If approved by the IURC, Fountaintown anticipates that the reduced charge would be applied to customers’ bills beginning in late May 2023 and the charge would go to zero for bills issued in late June 2023.
